

MISTI MILLIPEDE SCARF

*A super-soft, quick-to-knit fun and funky scarf to jazz up your fall and winter wardrobe!
Can also be used as a hand puppet!*

Materials:

3 Skeins Misti Alpaca Chunky Handpaint (held double throughout)
10 mm needles
2 large beads or buttons for eyes (optional)

Abbreviations:

BO = Bind Off	KFB = Knit into front and back of stitch
CO = Cast On	K2TOG = Knit 2 Together
K = Knit	SKPO = Slip 1, Knit 1, Pass Slipped Stitch Over

Pattern:

CO 4 sts.

Row 1: K1, KFB, KFB, K1
Row 2: Knit (6sts)
Row 3: K1, KFB, K2, KFB, K1
Row 4: Knit (8sts)
Row 5: K1, KFB, K4, KFB, K1
Row 6: Knit (10sts), using knitted cast-on, CO 5 sts
Row 7: BO 5 sts, K10, CO 5 sts

Rep Row 7 until scarf is desired length or 1 meter of yarn is left.

Row 8: BO 5 sts, K10
Row 9: K1, SKPO, K4, K2TOG, K1
Row 10: Knit (8sts)
Row 11: K1, SKPO, K2, K2TOG, K1
Row 12: Knit (6sts)
Row 13: K1, SKPO, K2TOG, K1
Row 14: BO remaining 4 sts.

Weave in ends and attach beads/buttons for eyes on one end (if using).

To use as hand puppet attach a small garter stitch band to underside of head to slide your hand through.
